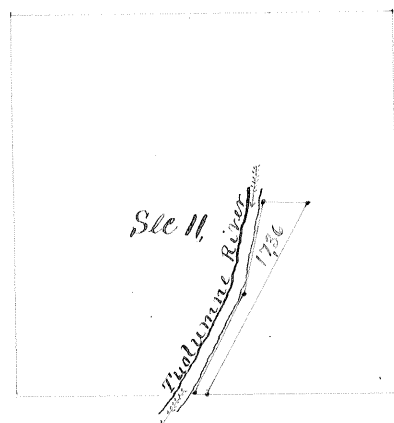

of the Tuolumne River, meander down stream, run $S 12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W 20.00$ ch.
 $S 27\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} W 23$ ch. to Section line between Sections 11 & 14 run on Section
line East 2.61 ch. to the place of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian: Magnetic Variation, 15.45 East.
