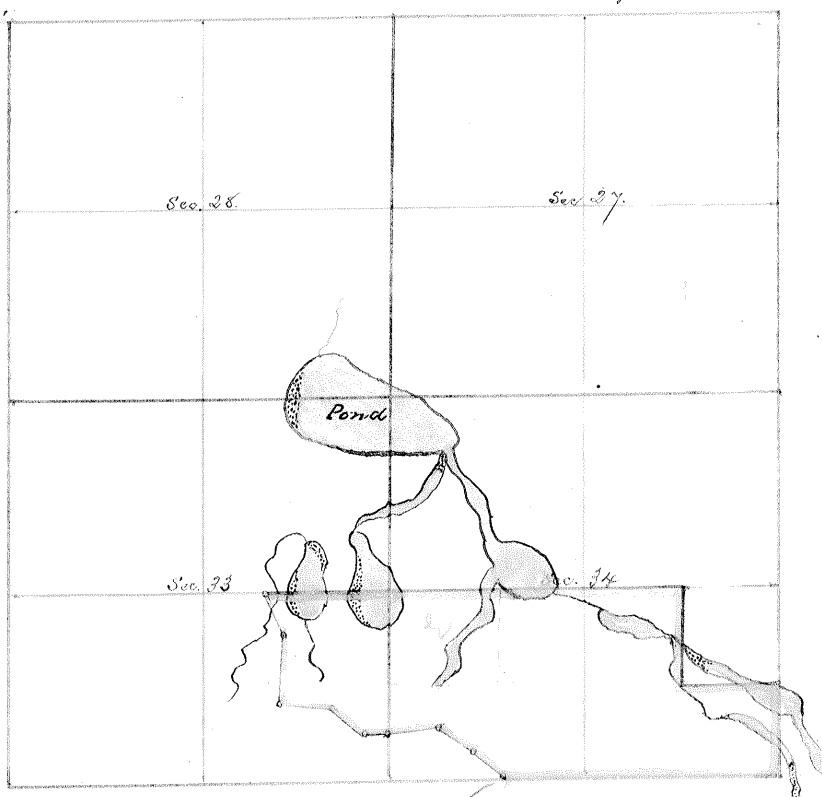

Field Notes.

Beginning at $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner set in the centre of Sec 34, Town
South range, East. Mt Diablo meridian, thence E 20 chains to set
post and mound; thence South 20 chains to set post and mound in
the edge of slough, thence East 20 chains to set post and mound,
thence South 20 chains to corner of sections 34 + 35 on the South
boundary of Township, thence West along said boundary of said
Township 57 chains to intersect with U.S. meander line on the
right margin of San Joaquin river; thence along said meander
line down stream N 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 9 ch, N 54 W 8 ch, N 82 W 9 ch, N 84 W 1 ch,
N 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 6 ch, W 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 8 ch, S 89 W 11 ch, N 5 E 15 ch, N 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 8.67 ch
to a post and mound set at intersection of E & W $\frac{1}{4}$ section line on sec
33, thence east 66.01 chains to point of beginning.

Run by the true Meridian, Magnetic Variation 15° 45' E.
